TRAILER RACE

RULES AND REGULATIONS

As of 7/26/22

CAR REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) O.E.M. full frame or Unibody V-8/V-6 cars or trucks with a minimum wheel base of 106". Any other or unique vehicles must be approved by speedway.
- 2) All glass must be removed from car AND trailer, excluding windshield. Windshield may be reinforced.
- 3) Stock gas tank must be replaced by a (max 6 gal) boat tank. Boat tank must be secured and covered. NO MORE THAN 2 GALLONS OF GAS IN TANK. Call speedway if fuel pump is located in tank.
- 4) Helmet, gloves and Long sleeve clothing required. ONLY ONE person (driver) in vehicle.
- 5) All vehicles and trailers must be inspected before participating in the event.
- 6) Unless other arraignments have been made, any vehicle left at Speedway or Fairgrounds for more than 72 hours will be considered abandon.

TRAILER REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) Trailers must be a: camper, boat and trailer, pop-up or utility trailer (utility trailers must be approved by speedway for size, build and content.
- 2) No manure spreaders, farm equipment or home made units.
- 3) Remove all glass. No loose junk- OR JUNK in trailers allowed. Remove all junk BEFORE you arrive.
- 4) DON'T BE DISAPPOINTED AND TURNED AWAY....ALL TRAILERS MUST BE APPROVED BY SPEEDWAY.
- 5) NO JUNK IN TRAILERS. They must be cleaned out BEFORE bringing them to Speedway.

RACE REQUIREMENTS:

1) YOU MUST ATTEND DRIVERS MEETING TO COMPETE.

- 2) This is not a race ... it is a show. Use your head!!
- 3) WATCH THE FLAGMAN.
- 4) DO NOT hit anyone in the drivers' door.
- 5) The track may be watered down.
- 6) Stay away from front stretch fence.
- 7) DO NOT damage the racetrack. If you can not move and are hung up, relax we will get you going again.
- 8) The fans' decides who wins. See rule #1.
- 9) If you lose your trailer.....you make attack trailers that our disabled for a *few* laps......Watch the flag man.
- 10) STAY IN YOUR CAR if you become disabled.
- 11) SPEEDWAY MAY LIMIT THE NUMBER OF ENTRIES TO 20 TRAILERS. CALL TO CONFIRM SPACE.
- 12) This is a fun event. It is not a sporting event. Don't participate if you cannot accept this.

PAY OUT for Saturday night race event:

- 1) You must pre-register with the Speedway Office (608-786-1525 or info@lacrossespeedway.com) 7 days prior to the event to receive the purse listed below.
- 2) Our car and our trailer- thank you.
- 3) Your car and our trailer- \$50 (must compete in a minimum of 25% of race*)
- 4) Your car and your approved camping trailer- Pop-ups- \$75, Hard side \$150 (must compete in a minimum of 25% of race*)
- 5) Your car and your approved trailer (other than camping) \$30., Boats with boat trailer- \$65. (must compete in a minimum of 25% of race*).
- 6) If you receive a pay out, trailers become property of the Speedway.
- * = If you are stuck or damaged in a manner that you can't compete, the 25% is waived.
