

TRAILER RACE

RULES AND REGULATIONS

AS OF 6-2-2026

VEHICAL REQUIREMENTS:

1. O.E.M. full frame or Unibody SUV, Van, or Truck with a minimum wheelbase of 106". No sedans or cars will be allowed. Any other or unique vehicle must be approved by the speedway.
2. Aftermarket bumpers must not extrude past the body of vehicle. No sharp points or edges.
3. Windshield may be reinforced.(Recommended)
4. Brakes must be working at the beginning of the race.
5. No more than two gallons of gas in tank.
6. Helmet, Gloves, and Long Sleeve clothing is required. Only one person (driver) in vehicle
7. All vehicles and trailers must be inspected before participating in the event. Inspection will open at 12:00 PM the day of the event and close at 5:30 PM. You MUST attend the drivers meeting at 5:45 PM to participate in the event.
8. Unless other arrangements have been made, any vehicle left at the speedway or fairgrounds for more than 72 hours after the event will be considered abandoned and will be property of LaCrosse Speedway.

TRAILER REQUIREMENTS:

1. Trailer Hitch required ball, pintail, pin hitch, clasp. No straps or chains tying trailer to vehicle.
2. BOAT RACE: No boat trailers, boats will be dragged behind vehicle with strap/chain. All motors, lower units, propellers, and/or gas tanks must be removed. All fuel must be removed. No sailboats or boat too large deemed by speedway officials. Call if questions.
3. Trailers must be a: camper, boat and trailer, or pop-up. NO utility trailers will be allowed. All trailers must add to the show.
4. No manure spreaders, farm equipment, or homemade units.
5. Remove all glass from trailer. No loose junk, garbage, or any other rubbish allowed in trailers. Remove all junk BEFORE you arrive or pay disposal fee \$50-\$250+ and/or \$10 per tire.
6. Don't be disappointed if you are turned away. All trailer trailers must pass inspection and you must pre-enter.
7. No junk in trailers. They MUST be cleaned out BEFORE bringing them to speedway.
8. No propane tanks, batteries, spare tires, etc

RACE REQUIREMENTS

1. You must attend the drivers meeting to compete. It will be held at 5:45 PM on race day in the pit area.
2. This is not a race... it's a show. Use your head!
3. Watch the flagman
4. DO NOT hit anyone in the drivers door.

5. The track may be watered down
6. Stay away from the frontstretch fence
7. DO NOT damage the race track. If you cannot move or are hung up, relax and we will get you going again. Reverse if your friend. Do NOT sit there and hit the gas if you are not moving.
8. The fans decide the winner. See rule 1
9. If you lose your trailer... you may attack trailers that are diablef for a few laps. Watch the flagman
10. Sobriety is MANDATORY.
11. RACECEIVERS ARE REQUIRED. They will be provided if you do not have one. Available at Pit Concession Stand. (\$20 deposit or valid drivers license)
12. NEVER EXIT YOUR CAR DURING THE RACE. Stay in your car if you become disabled. Only exit if directed by a speedway office or if you are in immediate danger.
13. SPEEDWAY **WILL LIMIT THE AMOUT OF ENTRIES TO 20**. YOU MUST REGISTER IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO COMPETE. CALL TO CONFIRM SPACE.
14. This is a fun event. It is not a sporting event. Do not participate if you cannot accept this.

PROCEDURES

1. You must attend the drivers meeting to participate. Failure to attend the drivers meeting will forfeit your entry in the event for that night.
2. Space is limited to 20 entries. If you pre-register and are a no show you will not be allowed in the next two trailer races/boat races.
3. House Trailers are first come first serve and will be marked LFS. If a trailer has a number on it that is not for the taking.
4. Inspection will begin at 12:00 PM noon on race day and will conclude at 5:30 PM. You must be inspected in order to participate in the event. Failure to be inspected will result in not being able to race
5. Winner based on fan vote. Trailer does not need to be connected to win. This is a show.

PAYOUT FOR TRAILER RACE

1. **You must** pre-register with the speedway office (608-786-1525 or info@lacrossespeedway.com) 7 days prior to the event to receive the purse listed below.
2. Our car and our trailer – thank you.
3. **Your car** and **our trailer** - \$50 (must compete minimum of 25% or race*)
4. **Your car** and **your approved** camping trailer – pop ups \$75, hard side \$150 (must compete in a minimum of 25% of race*)
5. **Your car** and **your approved** trailer (other than camping) - \$30., Boats with boat trailer - \$65. (must compete in a minimum of 25% of race*)
6. If you receive a pay out, trailer become property of the Speedway.

*if you are stuck or damaged in a manner that you can't compete, the 25% is waived.
